#### Rental Assistance Program (RAP)

RAP provides Emergency Rental Assistance for income eligible people in Santa Cruz County

- 1. Families with children
- 2. People with disabilities (temporary or permanent)
- 3. People 60 years of age or older
- 4. Must have a rental agreement or lease
